Fall Exhibition & Sale of Original Art

Sunday, October 21st

Capital Hotel, Kenmount Road

12 noon – 7 pm

The following criteria will apply to this show:

1. each member can enter up to 4 pieces of artwork
2. original artwork only will be accepted/ no size restriction
3. all worked must be framed or on gallery* canvas
*Gallery canvas protrudes more than 3/4 in from the wall, anything narrower is not gallery canvas.
4. the fee will be \$5.00 per piece entered
5. AANL will charge 15% commission on all work sold.
6. Work must be dropped off between 8 am and 10 am Oct 21.

Completed registration forms must be provided.

Please note: AANL board members will review all artwork prior to show opening to ensure that each piece meets the criteria set out . Any pieces not meeting the standard will be removed from display. This is necessary to be fair to all artists involved.

Important Notice:

1. Registration must be completed before art work is placed in room.
2. All membership fees must be paid in full prior to registering and/or placing artwork in room. There will be a separate registration table.
3. AANL is not responsible for any damage to artwork. All work remains the responsibility of the artist while on display. Artists must pick up all work or ensure that piece/s sold are either picked up by, or delivered to, the purchaser at the end of the show.

Your information must be sent to Dora Cooper by **Sunday, October 14** to allow time to prepare the schedule for the show. The following information must be provided for each piece of artwork:

Title of the piece

Medium

Price

Artist name

Any members not providing this information, will not have their artwork accepted into the show.
